

STEP CDG CLOSING REASONS 2015-2016

CDG CLOSING REASONS	DEFINITIONS
1. After Initial Contact Client Refused/Declined Services	Within 2 weeks of beginning services, youth declined to continue.
2. Incarcerated	Youth unable to participate in program as a result of incarceration.
3. Moved Out Of Service Area	Youth moved out of Broward County.
4. Participant Died	
5. Participant Dropped-out of Program (Stopped Showing Up)	Youth was engaged in program, but stopped attending with or without notification OR youth did not complete program requirements.
6. Successfully Completed Program	Based on program's determination, youth is ready for unsupported employment, accepted into a supported employment program with VR (not just applied), or entering a post-secondary education program.
7. Transferred To Another Provider/Funder Prior to Completion of Program	Youth was engaged in program but required alternative services prior to program completion (e.g., youth transferred to another provider because of location).
8. Successfully Engaged in Program	Youth engaged in all aspects of programming, but at completion, was not either ready for employment, accepted by VR for supported employment program, or entering post-secondary education.
9. Health Problems	Youth was engaged in program but stopped with notice because of health barriers to participation.
10. Lack of Transportation Services	Youth was engaged in program, but became unable to attend because of a change in transportation options.
11. Closed to Continue New Contract	Youth was engaged in program at the end of an RFP period and expected to continue participation in new RFP period.
